One of the best of the season in fact was turned in by our winner Rich McD who went real low with a 95 net 63 from the Black tees. Second place was a tie between our 2 lowest handicappers as both Rainman and Tim-E-Way both shot 81 net 71 at the tricky Rutgers track. Hard luck 4th went to Swanny who finished one stroke of their pace.

Interestingly these results have no impact at the top of the order other than to bring a few new guys closer to the top as we get ready to head down the back stretch of the season. IN the OOM Eddie still leads Little Buddy by 5, and Mullet by 8, with Skipper, Newman, and XLP 13 points back.
